Do you have any hobbies? Ballet Dancing and running

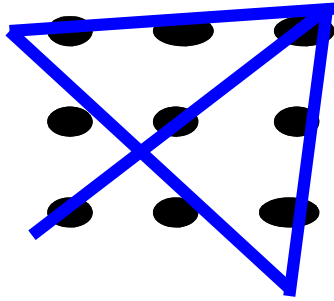
Do you have any pets? Yes, three cats and 3 fish.

We have been learning all about the different techniques of how to sew, for example backstitching.

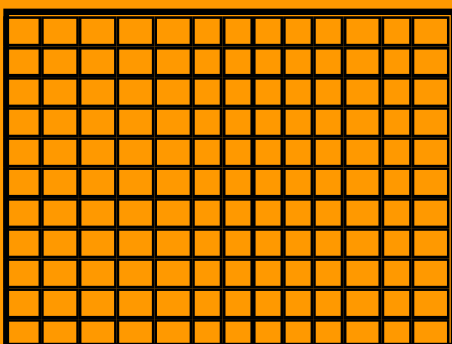
